You are about to purchase a product that is not simple and may be difficult to understand.

What is this product?

Type

The Sub-fund is part of BICE Inversiones fund. This document relates to BICE Inversiones, a Luxembourg investment company with variable capital established in the form of a public limited liability company. The Depositary is UBS Europe SE.

Term

The investment horizon is medium term and should be at least 3 years.

Objectives

The primary objective of the Sub-Fund is to achieve high level of income. The Sub-Fund invests in a diversified portfolio of fixed and floating rate securities from government institutions and companies incorporated or having their principal business activities in the Latin American and Caribbean region.

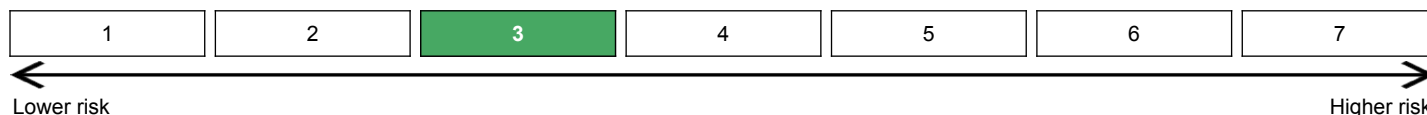
The Sub-Fund will seek to hold a minimum of 70% of its assets in Latin American & Caribbean corporate (which includes financials) debt instruments of Latin American & Caribbean issuers. The Sub-Fund may also be exposed to sovereign bonds, investment grade bonds and high yield bonds which may vary according to market conditions. As a consequence, investment may be higher in high yield or investment grade. Under normal conditions, the portfolio will be exposed to investment grade bonds for 50% and to high yield bonds for 50%, with a variation of up to 10%. The limit will be up to 75% in investment grade and/or high yield bonds when US treasury yields and interest rates are expected to rise. The Sub-Fund can invest in bonds rated less than B- by any of the three major rating agencies (i.e. S&P, Moody's and Fitch) and Distressed Securities up to 5% of its assets. For treasury purposes, residual assets will be invested in debt securities of other issuers such as eligible commercial paper or money market funds, or cash and cash equivalents.

Intended retail investor

Reserved for retail and institutional investors. The Sub-Fund is designed for investors who are able to assess the risks and the value of the investment.

What are the risks and what could I get in return?

Risk Indicator:



The risk indicator assumes you keep the product for 3 years.

The summary risk indicator is a guide to the level of risk of this product compared to other products. It shows how likely it is that the product will lose money because of movements in the markets or because the fund is not able to pay you.

We have classified this product as 3 out of 7, which is a medium-low risk class.

This rates the potential losses from future performance at a medium-low level, and poor market conditions are unlikely to impact our capacity to pay you.

Be aware of currency risk. You will receive payments in a different currency, so the final return you will get depends on the exchange rate between the two currencies. This risk is not considered in the indicator shown above.

The stress scenario shows what you might get back in extreme market circumstances.

Unfavourable scenario: This type of scenario occurred for an investment between 30/09/2021 and 30/09/2022 (If you exit after 1 year), 30/10/2020 and 31/10/2023 (If you exit after 3 years).

Moderate scenario: This type of scenario occurred for an investment between 30/11/2015 and 30/11/2016 (If you exit after 1 year), 29/07/2016 and 31/07/2019 (If you exit after 3 years).

Favourable scenario: This type of scenario occurred for an investment between 31/01/2017 and 31/01/2018 (If you exit after 1 year), 31/03/2015 and 30/03/2018 (If you exit after 3 years).

What happens if Adepa Asset Management S.A. is unable to pay out?

The investments of the fund are held separately from the assets of Adepa Asset Management S.A. as fund management company and from the corresponding custodian bank. Thus, you will not lose your investment in the event of a possible insolvency of Adepa Asset Management S.A.

What are the costs?

Costs over Time

The tables show the amounts that are taken from your investment to cover different types of costs. These amounts depend on how much you invest, how long you hold the product and how well the product does. The amounts shown here are illustrations based on an example investment amount and different possible investment periods.

We have assumed:

- In the first year you would get back the amount that you invested (0 % annual return). For the other holding periods we have assumed the product performs as shown in the moderate scenario.

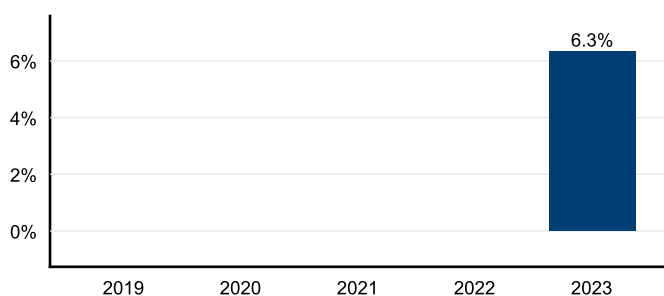
