You are about to purchase a product that is not simple and may be difficult to understand.

What is this product?

Type

The Sub-Fund is part of PEGASO CAPITAL SICAV, is a Luxembourg Investment Company (société d'investissement à capital variable) that has been established for an unlimited period in the form of an umbrella fund (the "Investment Company" or "Fund") with one or more sub-funds in accordance with Part I of the Luxembourg Law of 17 December 2010 relating to undertakings for collective investment, as amended. The Depositary is QUINTET PRIVATE BANK (EUROPE) S.A.

Term

The investment horizon is medium term and should be at least 3 years.

Objectives

The investment policy of the Sub-Fund is to generate positive annual returns while actively dampening the volatility of monthly returns. The Sub-Fund is actively managed, without any reference to a benchmark.

The Sub-Fund aims to invest primarily in eligible derivatives, including but not limited to exchange traded derivatives and over-the-counter derivatives, such as options, swaps and futures on transferable securities, money market instruments, financial indices, interest rates, and currencies.


The Fund Manager will be able to use derivative strategies as part of his investment strategy. In this regard, a volatility management approach relying on some structural elements and on accurate ex -ante risk controlling will be used. The most important structural elements aimed at limiting volatility are: the very strong preference for investing cash in high-quality bonds in order to reach a moderate average level of sensitivity to interest rate changes, the insignificance of direct investments in equities, and a focus on conservative derivative strategies which will be detailed below. In addition to this, the portfolio management team will constantly check and balance the prospective (ex-ante) level of risk embedded in the fund positions by regularly conducting Value-At-Risk and Stress Scenario analyses.

The Sub-Fund will not invest in contingent convertible bonds, non-performing bonds (with credit ratings below B-), or defaulted bonds.

Intended retail investor

The Sub-Fund is suitable for growth-oriented shareholders. Due to the composition of the net sub-fund assets, there is a high degree of overall risk, but also a high degree of profit potential. Minimum initial investment EUR 1,000.00, however The Management Company is authorised to accept lower amounts at its discretion

What are the risks and what could I get in return?



The risk indicator assumes you keep the product for 3 years.

You may not be able to sell end your product easily or you may have to sell end at a price that significantly impacts on how much you get back.

The summary risk indicator is a guide to the level of risk of this product compared to other products. It shows how likely it is that the product will lose money because of movements in the markets or because the fund is not able to pay you.

We have classified this product as 3 out of 7, which is a medium-low risk class.

This rates the potential losses from future performance at a medium-low level, and poor market conditions are unlikely to impact our capacity to pay you.

Be aware of currency risk. You will receive payments in a different currency, so the final return you will get depends on the exchange rate between the two currencies. This risk is not considered in the indicator shown above.

Unfavourable scenario: This type of scenario occurred for an investment between December 2021 and December 2022 (If you exit after 1 year), December 2020 and December 2023 (If you exit after 3 years).

Moderate scenario: This type of scenario occurred for an investment between December 2022 and December 2023 (If you exit after 1 year), February 2016 and February 2019 (If you exit after 3 years).

Favourable scenario: This type of scenario occurred for an investment between August 2018 and August 2019 (If you exit after 1 year), December 2017 and December 2020 (If you exit after 3 years).

What happens if Adepa Asset Management S.A. is unable to pay out?

The investments of the fund are held separately from the assets of Adepa Asset Management S.A. as fund management company and from the corresponding custodian bank. Thus, you will not lose your investment in the event of a possible insolvency of Adepa Asset Management S.A.

What are the costs?

Costs over Time

- In the first year you would get back the amount that you invested (0 % annual return). For the other holding periods we have assumed the product performs as shown in the moderate scenario.


